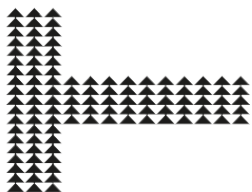

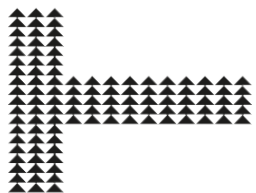
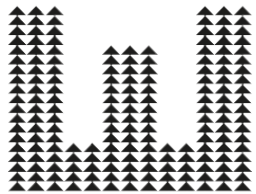
The workshop begins with storytelling followed by learning carving techniques. Workshop participants will be guided in creating their own Pacific design to carve their own unique pieces.
